



PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT NO 1. OF KITTITAS COUNTY – SCHEDULE 102P

**Commercial Service – Primary**

**Availability:**

Available to all single and three phase customers for all uses that prefer service at higher voltage level. High voltage (primary) customers furnish, operate and maintain all facilities beyond the primary meter. This includes step-down transformers, protective equipment, capacitor banks and all other facilities needed by the customer in distributing and utilizing the delivered power and energy. Highly intermittent power loads such as hay-presses, rock crushers, x-ray machines, elevators, and similar loads which may cause undue fluctuations, will not be served unless approved by the District. Service hereunder is subject to the established rules and regulations of the District.

**Type of Service:**

Single phase and three phase at available voltages, normally 7200/12470

**Monthly Rate:**

Facilities Charge:

Single Phase .....	\$103.25/month
Three Phase .....	\$103.25/month

Energy Charge:

First 20,000 kWh .....	\$.0754/kWh
Over 20,000 kWh.....	\$.0475/kWh

Demand Charge:

All kW .....	\$5.25/kW
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**Determination of Billing Demand:**

The billing demand shall be the maximum kilowatt load used by the consumer for any consecutive 15-minute period during the month as indicated or recorded by a demand meter.

**Minimum Charge:**

The minimum monthly charge under this rate shall be \$103.25 for single phase and \$103.25 for three phase accounts.

**Power Factor:**


The customer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted to correct for average power factor lower than 95%.

**Terms of Payment:**

Payable upon receipt. Bills unpaid after the due date will be charged interest at the rate of 1% monthly.
