Schedule 1003, 1013

Irrigation Service, Less than 100 HP

Availability:

This schedule covers service separately metered and used exclusively for farm and domestic irrigation purposes. Single phase motors of 7.5 hp or less may be connected. All three phase motors larger than 30 hp must have starting equipment that meets the approval of the District.

Type of Service:

Single phase at available secondary voltages, normally 120/240 or 240/480.

Three phase at available secondary voltages, normally 120/208, 240/480 or 277/480.

Seasonal Rate (1003):

Horsepower Charge	\$22.70/hp/season (or a minimum of \$227/season, whichever is greater)
Energy Charge.....	\$.0562/kWh
Demand Charge (over 50 kW)...	\$5.10/kW

Off Season Rate (1013):

Facilities Charge	\$15.00/month
Energy Charge.....	\$.0854/kWh
Demand Charge (over 50 kW)....	\$5.10/kW

Minimum Annual Charge:

If a pump is idle for the full pumping season, there will be a discount of 50% of the annual horsepower charge provided that such discount will not reduce the annual billing to less than the Minimum Annual Charge for single phase service of \$227.00 This discount will be allowed only after the completion of the pumping season.

Irrigation Season:

The period within each calendar year from April 15 to October 15, inclusive. All other energy will be billed at the off-season rate.

Power Factor:

The customer agrees to maintain unity power factor as nearly as practicable. Demand charges will be adjusted to correct for average power factor lower than 95%.

Terms of Payment:

Payable upon receipt. Bills unpaid after the due date will be charged interest at the rate of 1% monthly.

Effective Date:

This rate schedule shall become effective January 21, 2012.
